Edison developed many skills when he was young. He sold candy and newspapers on trains and sold vegetables to increase his income. He also studied analysis and did experiments on the train until an accident stopped his further work. Later, Edison **obtained** the right to sell newspapers on the road. He discovered his talent as a businessman through all these jobs. This talent eventually led him to found 14 companies, including General Electric, **which** is still one of the largest companies in the world.

He invented many devices that greatly influenced life around the world, including the phonograph, the motion picture camera, and the light bulb.
