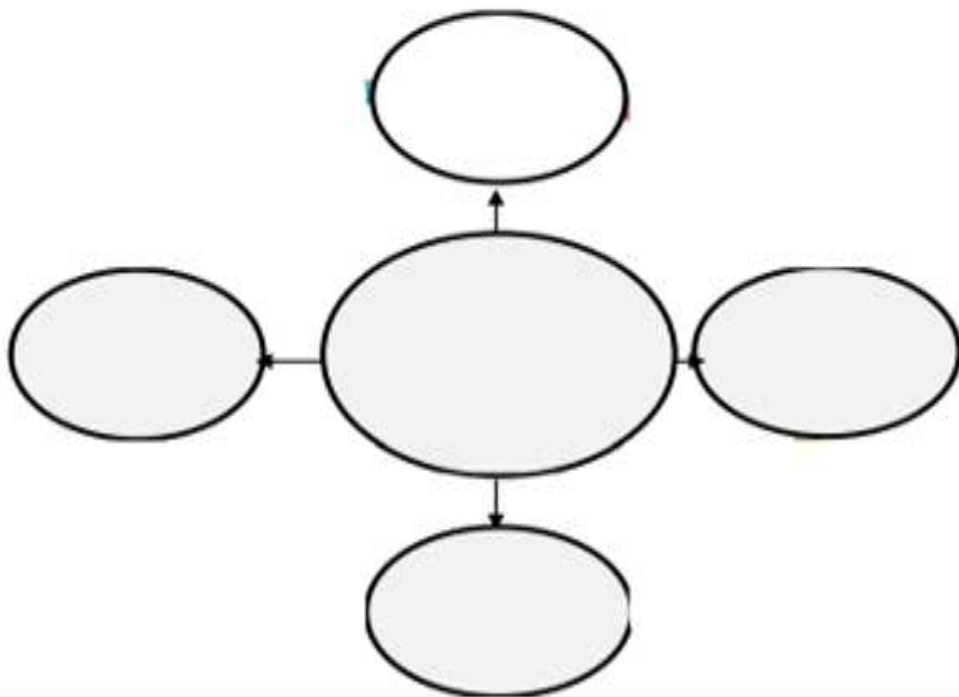

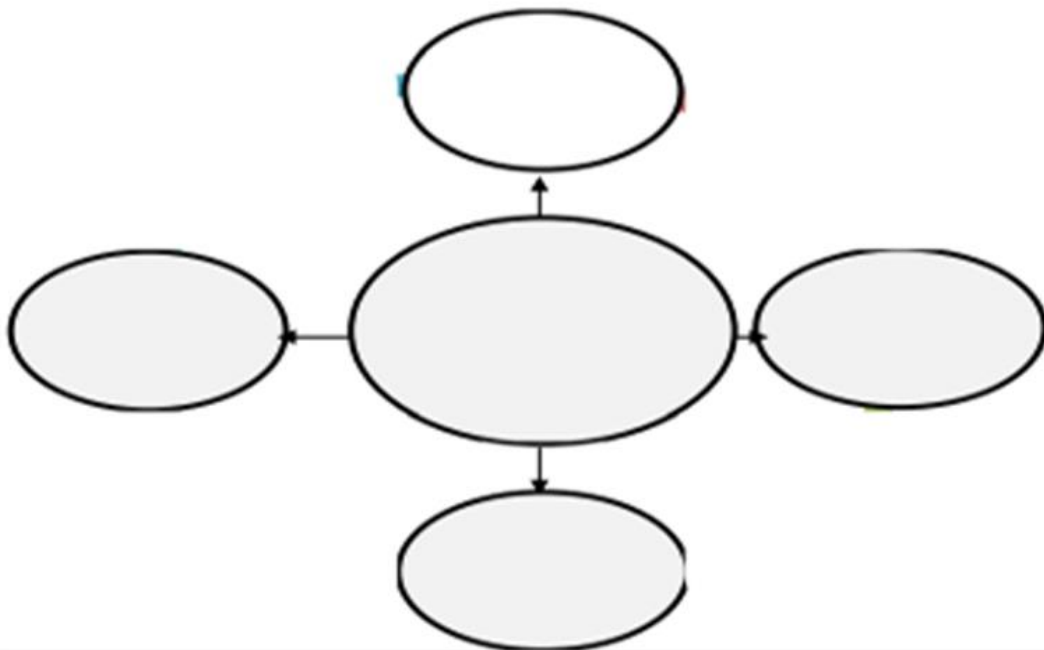

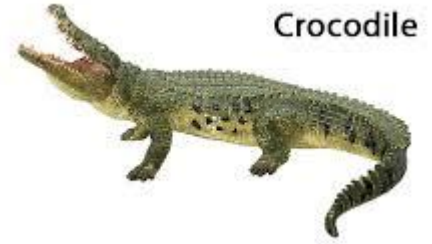

Crocodile

Crocodiles spend most of their time in the water but they can also travel on land. The skin of crocodiles is very strong. The eyes and the ears of a crocodile are on its head. Crocodiles mostly feed on fish, birds, turtles and other small animals by catching them and pulling them to the water.
