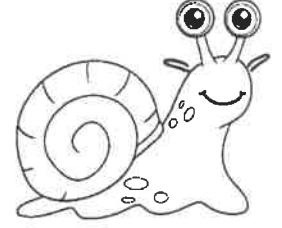

Snails are fascinating creatures. They are known for their slow movement and unique spiral shells. You can find snails in **various** environments, including gardens, forests, and even underwater!



One of the most interesting things about snails is their shell. The shell is made of calcium carbonate and grows with the snail. It protects them from other animals and bad weather. Snails can pull their bodies back into their shells when they feel threatened. Snails move using foot under their bodies. This foot produces mucus, a slimy substance, that helps them move smoothly over surfaces. The mucus also protects their soft bodies from sharp objects and rough surfaces.

Snails have two pairs of tentacles on their heads. The longer pair has eyes at the tips, which help **them** see, while the shorter pair is used for smelling and feeling their surroundings. They also have a tongue-like organ with tiny teeth, which they use to take food off surfaces. Snails eat a variety of things, including leaves and fruits.

Snails are also known for their slow movement. Despite their slow speed, snails can travel surprisingly long distances for food and shelter.

In addition to being interesting to watch, snails play an important role in the ecosystem. They help break up dead plants and recycle nutrients back into the soil. So, the next time you see a snail, take a moment to appreciate these amazing little creatures!

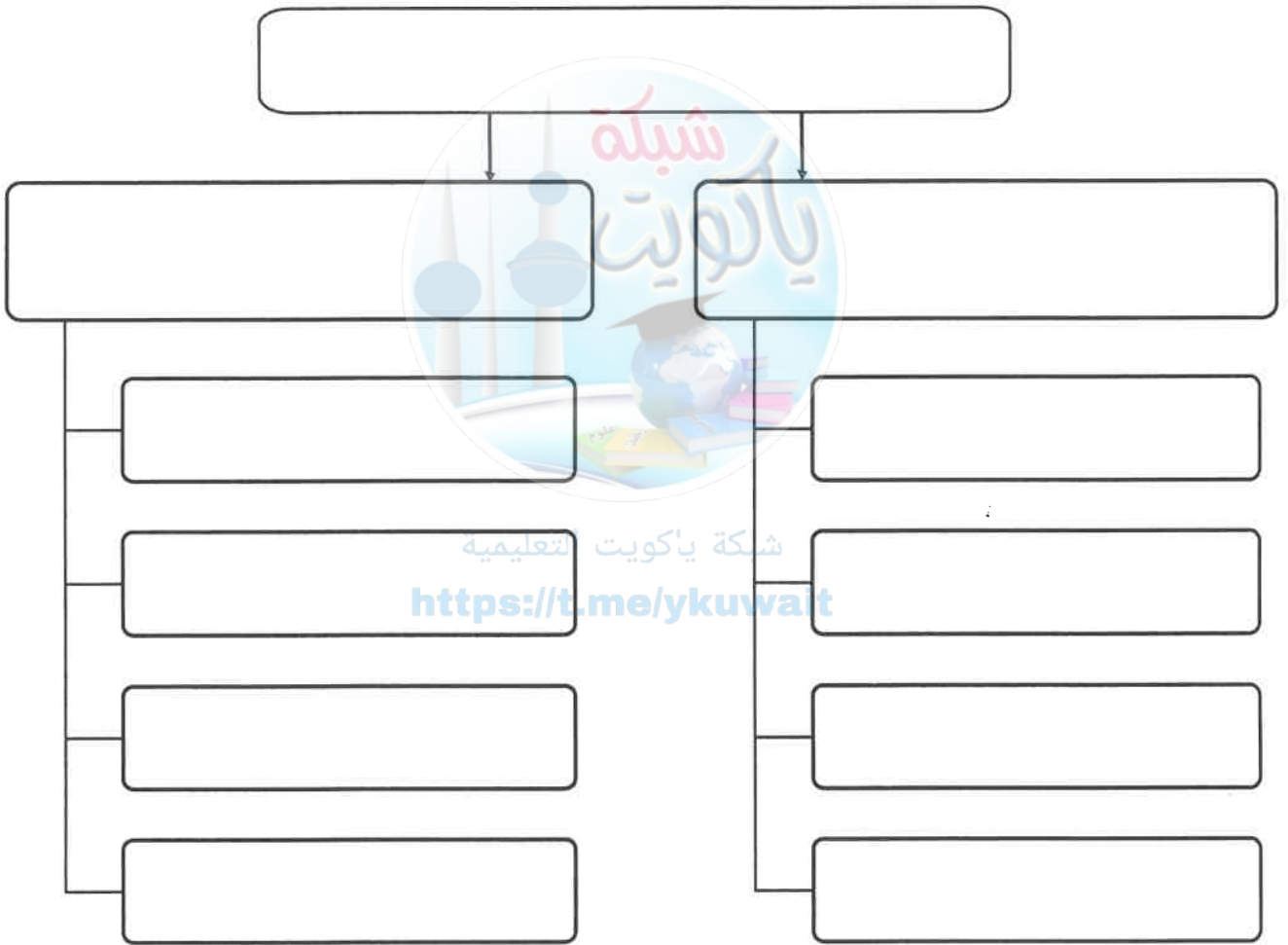
