The first electric traffic light had only red and green lights; it did not have a yellow light like modern-day traffic signals. Instead of a yellow light, it had a bell sound that was used to show that the signal would be changing soon. In the year 1920, a policeman named William Potts in Detroit, Michigan invented the first four-way and three-coloured traffic lights. Apart from red and green, a third colour – was introduced. It was the yellow one. Detroit became the first city to apply the four-way and three-coloured traffic lights.

At present, traffic all over the world can be observed and the lights can also be adjusted in the case of difficulties or dangers by computers . Computers have very much improved the handling of traffic . **They** increased total road safety.


