Maps also have historical and cultural value. Old maps show how people in the past understood the world. They show changes in borders, places' names, and how cities grew over time. Maps help **preserve** history and show how humans explored and discovered new places.

Paper maps are useful in situations where digital maps may not work. In areas with poor internet or during power cuts, smartphones and GPS may fail. Paper maps do not need electricity or signals to function, so travellers, hikers, and explorers can rely on them.

In conclusion, maps are still very important today. They help people learn, work, and understand history. Technology has changed the way we use maps, but it has not replaced their value. Maps remain essential tools for understanding and navigating the world.
