## COMPARATIVE

We use comparative adjectives to compare **two** things.

**Short adjectives**  
adjective + **er**

tall → **taller**  
fast → **faster**

**Long adjectives**  
**more** + adjective

beautiful → **more** beautiful  
expensive → **more** expensive

## SUPERLATIVE

We use superlative adjectives to compare **three or more** things.

**Short adjectives**  
the + adjective + **est**

tall → **the tallest**  
fast → **the fastest**

**Long adjectives**  
**the most** + adjective

beautiful → **the most** beautiful  
expensive → **the most** expensive

## IRREGULAR ADJECTIVES

good → **better** → **best**

bad → **worse** → **worst**

far → **further** → **furthest**

# PRESENT PERFECT

(WITH SINCE & FOR)

## FORM:

Subject + **have / has** + past participle

- I **have** lived.
- She **has** studied.

## SINCE

We use **since** with a starting point.

START  
2020

→ NOW

### EXAMPLES:

- I have lived here **since** 2020.
- She has studied English **since** September.
- They have played football **since** morning.



## FOR

We use **for** with a period of time.

2 YEARS

NOW

→

### EXAMPLES:

- I have lived here **for** five years.
- She has studied English **for** two months.
- They have played football **for** three hours.
