



A library is a great place for students to visit to get help with school work. A library is a collection of resources in a variety of formats, available to people for reference or borrowing. A library's collection of resources can include books, newspapers, films and other formats. There will always be someone there to help you find what you want. That person is the librarian. Here is some fascinating information about libraries.

The largest library in the world is The Library of Congress, with more than 158 million items on approximately 838 miles of bookshelves. The Library was built in 1800. It has provided books to the blind in braille and on sound recordings which have later been replaced with newly developed Digital Talking Books and digital playback equipment.

The smallest library in the world has appeared on the streets of New York City – and it has space for just one reader at a time. It houses 40 books and mainly aims to help city-dwellers take a break from the fast pace of life in large cities by relaxing with a good story. The Little Free Library was made from a plastic water tank and a wooden frame, with holes in the outside allowing visitors to look in before **they** enter.

The highest library according to Guinness World Records is on the 60th floor of the JW Marriott Hotel at Tomorrow Square in Shanghai, China. It is **situated** at 230.9 metres above street level. It contains an ever-increasing collection of Chinese and English books.
